

# Policy for Storing Instruments in the Band Room



The school provides storage space for instruments to be kept in the band room during the school day. Students are recommended to use the band room storage areas, although they are not required to do so. Every effort is made to insure security of these instruments; however, the school, district, band director, and administration may not be held liable in the event of damage, loss, or theft of an instrument. The band room is locked when not in use. It is generally accepted that leaving an instrument in a locker or another classroom is much less safe than leaving it in the band room. The district has provided a security system to help protect instruments and the contents of the band room when school is not in session; however, it is not recommended that students leave instruments at school over night. All of these facilities may be used at your own risk. It is also recommended that your name, address, and phone number should be visibly located on the instrument case.
